



LASOS was created in 2009, to make a difference in Harford County for the non-native English-speaking residents. Our goals are to:

- 1) By June 2021 97.9% of 100 non English-speaking residents surveyed reported an overall increase in their personal and professional growth as a result of participation in LASOS activities.
- 2) By June of 2021, 99.3% of 50 community businesses and residents surveyed reported and overall decrease in the cultural and language barriers experienced during assimilation
- 3) By June of 2021, 99.1% of 50 Harford County businesses and families surveyed reported an overall increase in level of community engagement as a result of participation in LASOS activities and services.



Did you know?

By July 1 2021 LASOS had achieved...

Engagement:

- 9,211 Members
- 357 volunteers
- 99% referral of new volunteers
- Over 7,286 walk ins / virtual appointments for resources
- 763 translation requests
- 3,286 members received health benefits

Education:

- 79% showed an increase of 1 language level
- 17% increased 2 language levels
- 820 hours of English Instruction
- 189 participants
- 100% increased leadership and academic skills
- 1425 hours of youth mentoring
- 821 students
- 102 peer mentors
- 16 people are now literate



Quality of Life:

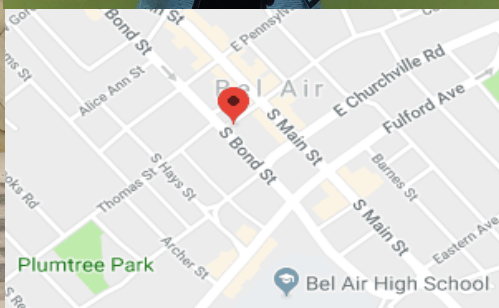
- 99% of 500 people surveyed reported:

 - 100% improved English skills
 - 98.2% satisfaction with services

Community Involvement:

- 150 children attend summer programming
- 78 participate in youth leadership
- 23 girls participate in a female empowerment group

Community Partnerships:

- 96 community organizations have become "Friends of LASOS"
- 33 community businesses have invested in our work at LASOS
