



Embrace Program

The Embrace Support Program is an intensive community-based intervention program that focuses on the child and family unit working in multiple sessions throughout the school year to address prevention, intervention, and diversion programs for at risk youth. With support and education, the youth has the skills needed to overcome adolescent behavior problems, conduct disorder, substance abuse, and delinquency.



Students in the program are partnered with a caring mentor that provides in-school Student Checkups, including wrap-around casework, with the goal of strengthening school life, and the personal life of the student.



Students are referred to the mentoring programs to foster social and leadership skills:

- Phoenix (boys 12+)
- Butterfly Group (girls 10+)

Additional academic support is available afterschool weekly:

- Grade Check-Ins
- Homework Help
- Peer Mentoring
