



LASOS was created in 2009, to make a difference in Harford County for the non-native English-speaking residents. Our goals are to:

- 1) By December 2025 98.1% of 100 non English-speaking residents surveyed reported an overall increase in their personal and professional growth as a result of participation in LASOS activities.
- 2) By December of 2025, 99.7% of 50 community businesses and residents surveyed reported and overall decrease in the cultural and language barriers experienced during assimilation
- 3) By December of 2025, 99.6% of 50 Harford County businesses and families surveyed reported an overall increase in level of community engagement as a result of participation in LASOS activities and services.

- 84% showed an increase of 1 language level when attending 90% of classes
- 15% increased 2 language levels

- 1647 hours of youth mentoring
- 1011 students
- 121 peer mentors
- 10 people are now literate
- 109 earned a better position at work



Quality of Life:

99% of 500 people surveyed reported:

- 100% improved professional skills
- 100% improved personal skills
- 100% improved English skills
- 99.2% satisfaction with services

Community Involvement:

- 347 children attend summer programming
- 92 participate in youth leadership
- 46 girls participate in a female empowerment group
- 24 boys in the Phoenix group
